## SITE ACTIVITY UPDATE

The current and upcoming site activities during August will be as follows:

- Crushing and processing of demolition arisings
- Structural floor by floor demolition of Hannibal House and progressive dismantling of scaffold
- Structural demolition of Shopping Centre South and processing of demolition arisings
- Pile probing
- Construction of a pit lane across the Peninsula
- Relocation of CCTV and lamp column along Walworth Road

## DEMOLITION UPDATE

High reach demolition of the Shopping Centre South is complete. Demolition of the remainder of the structures, and the processing of the arisings, will be carried out using demolition excavators



## BICYCLE STAND RELOCATION

As part of our S278 works we have successfully relocated and installed bike stands on the Peninsula and Walworth Road for cyclists to use.
