SITE ACTIVITY UPDATE



Superstructures progressi up to level 5 and 6



- Transfer beams that will support the load of the new structure above the Bakerloo Line tunnels are now complete and the Basement 3 slab is being poured above them to begin building the structure
- The work to link the district heating system to the new development via Elephant Road has begun
- The concrete core for the UAL building has now been poured to Level 10
- The concrete core for the E2 (34 storey residential tower) building has now been poured to Level 8 and columns are now installed up to Level 6
- Concrete cores for the other two residential tower buildings are now built to Level 3
- The last tower crane is due to be erected in the last quarter of 2023 (Oct-Dec)
- There are currently four gates in use across the project which are managed by teams of dedicated trained traffic marshals
- Multiplex is installing perimeter scaffold protection gantries along Walworth Road
- There are approximately 400 people on site in total, of which 300 are operatives
- Multiplex continues to encourage operatives to use local businesses

The Elephant and Castle Town Centre team and Get Living have announced the latest round of grant awards for the Inspiring Elephant Community Fund. The £50,000 a year fund, which is now in its second year, provides grants to local groups and organisations, supporting short-term projects and contributing to longer-term community initiatives in the community.

Local groups and organisations have been awarded grants of between $\pounds 2,500$ and $\pounds 4,950$ to support local community initiatives, with the Elephant and Castle Town Centre team and Get Living have announced the 12 successful applicants

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY UPDATE

CONSIDERATE CONSTRUCTORS SCHEME (CCS)

Following a recent CCS audit, the project was notified that two innovation points have been awarded taking the total score to 47. The points were awarded following the project effectively Footprinting impact on local air pollution.

CARBON REDUCTION

As of the end of August 2023, over 130 tonnes of carbon dioxide emissions have been saved through utilising a renewable energy tariff for all electricity consumption. This is the equivalent to taking 123 cars off UK roads for one year.

BIODIVERSITY

The project team has a further biodiversity volunteering day now arranged. This will take place within Southwark at Peckham Rye Park during October 2023.
