

- 2. Tower 1 (34 storey residential tower): Ventilation and cablework installed up to level 32
- 3. New UAL : LCC Campus Building: Tower crane which sat on top of the building dismantled
- The E1 (12 storey new London College of Communication building) concrete structure is complete, and façade installation has progressed up to level 11 on all elevations with roof finishes complete up to level 12. All 11 sets of the atrium feature stairs have been installed with final decorations now taking place. In addition, balustrade installation is now ongoing, and painting is nearing completion. The central atrium sky light at level 12 is currently under construction, with glazing now complete. The external goods hoist has now been dismantled, as has the tower crane which sat at the top of the building's concrete core.
- Façade installation on tower 1 (34 storey residential tower) has progressed up to level 34 and is now complete, as is bathroom pod installation. Internal fit out is progressing well, with ventilation ductwork and cable installation complete up to level 32. Apartment walls and ceilings are progressing in sequence behind the façade installation. Fit out 'white box', the term used for completion of the walls, floor and ceilings and utilities, has now been achieved up to Level 7.
- Façade panel installation on tower 2 (20 storey residential tower) and tower 3 (22 storey residential tower) is now complete on the residential areas, as is bathroom pod load out. Internal fit out works are now progressing in sequence, and fit out 'white box' has been achieved on level 3 of both towers on residential floors.
- There are currently three vehicle entry/exit gates and two external pit lanes in use across the project, managed by teams of dedicated trained traffic marshals through Multiplex's supply chain partner, Clipfine. Two tower cranes have recently been removed from the project, with a further crane due to be dismantled in December. We have recently moved the location of the site office and welfare accommodation to Walworth Road, with the previous site cabins near the Northern Line entrance now removed from site.
- At present, approximately 1,050 people are coming to work on the project every day, encompassing operatives (approximately 900) and management staff (approximately 150).

SOCIAL VALUE UPDATE

Multiplex continues to work with its supply chain teams to secure new employment opportunities. A supply chain meeting has been scheduled for Monday 2nd December to formally launch a new partnership with Bridge of Hope, who will support with publicising Multiplex's employment opportunities on the project.

Multiplex has chosen to support fun and happiness charity KidsOut! for its Christmas Charity Challenge. Throughout November and December, Multiplex will be collecting new toys to donate to the charity, which supports children and young people escaping domestic violence and abuse.

On Wednesday 4th December, Multiplex and one of its supply chain partners will be attending an Employment Day at HMP The Mount to talk to inmates about the construction industry and roles which may be available.

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY UPDATE

CARBON REDUCTION

The residential façade is nearing completion, and was designed to accommodate significant carbon savings. Once complete, this design change will have saved approximately 530 tonnes of carbon dioxide.

BUILDING-IN SUSTAINABILITY

The project is progressing well against the four BREEAM sustainability assessments targeted across the development. The finished development will include a range of diverse planting schemes as well as ecological features such as bat and bird boxes, helping to encourage wildlife back into the local area.



BACK THE BAKERLOO

The Bakerloo Line is synonymous with Elephant and Castle, having been the terminus for over a century. However, the future may look very different as plans are being developed to upgrade and extend the line.

New trains and signalling will see faster and more pleasant journeys for Elephant residents both to central London and along the Old Kent Road. The capacity of each train will be 10% higher and there will be 27 trains an hour compared to the current 20. The upgrade will also open more opportunities as the scheme will create circa 10,000 new homes, create circa 10,000 new jobs and boost the national economy by £1.5bn per year.
